

EWT 2018 Malawi Cheetah Experience Raffle Terms and Conditions

This raffle is offered only in South Africa to citizens and residents and governed according to the laws of the South African National Lotteries Commission. Participants need to be at least 18 years of age or older at the drawing of this raffle. 100% of all profit made goes to the Endangered Wildlife Trust's (EWT) Cheetah Conservation Project.

The raffle prize is a Malawi Cheetah experience at Liwonde National Park in Malawi. The prize includes round trip tickets from OR Tambo to Malawi with two nights' accommodation at Mvuu Lodge. During this trip, the participant will get the chance to track Cheetahs with an EWT Cheetah expert, and take part in two game activities.

A participant purchases a chance to win the prize. By entering this raffle, the participant agrees to the terms and conditions of this raffle hosted by the EWT and no claims may arise out of it.

- A ticket costs R500 (five hundred Rand) and 1,000 tickets will be available for purchase. There is no discount for multiple ticket purchases. One ticket equals one entry into the draw.
- The winner will be determined by a random drawing that takes place on 2 May 2019.
- Participants may enter the competition as many times as they like.
- The draw may not be entered by employees of the EWT.
- Only authorised members of the EWT may sell raffle tickets.
- Payment may only be made in cash (in person) or by credit card (online). Ticket purchases are not refundable. Participants must accurately record their information.
- Entries for the draw close at midnight on 30 April 2019, or when all tickets have been sold, whichever is first. Any entries received by the EWT after this date will be considered donations.
- The EWT accepts no responsibility for tickets which are lost, damaged, or illegible.
- The EWT accepts no responsibility for any technical failure or occurrence which causes the draw to be disrupted or cancelled.
- Winners will be notified by telephone and/or by email no later than five working days after the draw date.
- Should the prize be left unclaimed and uncollected for 14 days following the draw or the winner is determined to be ineligible or does not comply with the EWT's official rules, the prize will be forfeited by the original winner and a new winner will be drawn.
- Winners must present proof of identification to receive their prize.
- Winners are required meet with and collect their prizes from an EWT representative. The prize may not be transferred or exchanged for cash or any other goods or services.
- The winner has the opportunity to give their permission to have their name and image published on the EWT's social media and website.
- Winners are responsible for ensuring they have the necessary travel documents.
- The prize is valid until February 2020.
